And, while we are on the topic of August - the weather is...well, let's face, it's HOT! We know that colder days are ahead and with them, higher utility bills. At the Indianapolis Housing Agency, we want to make sure you and your family are prepared well in advance, especially if heating costs might become a burden this winter.

The Energy Assistance Program (EAP), also known as the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), is a federally funded program that helps income-eligible households cover heating costs during the winter season.

This assistance is especially helpful for families, seniors, and individuals living on a fixed income. Eligibility is based on household income from the past three months, and households earning at or below 60% of Indiana's State Median Income may qualify. All adult household members' income is taken into account (any adult 18 years and older).

We strongly encourage our residents who think they may qualify to learn more and apply early. Visit www.indyeap.org/eligibility to review the income guidelines, gather your documents, and begin the application process.

Please *don't wait until winter arrives*. Planning now can bring peace of mind and ensure your home stays warm and safe throughout the season.
